## **Fur Product Label**

The requirements of the Act are set forth below. The following reflects the elimination of the \$150 exemption effective March 18, 2011. The Fur Product Labeling Act covers all apparel, footwear, and hats.

## Real Fur:

The label must have the following requirements:

## Labeling:

- 1. The label stating "real fur"
- 2. Animal name
- 3. Name or RN of the manufacturer, importer, marketer or distributor
- 4. Country of origin of the fur preceded by the phrase, "fur origin"
- 5. Whether the fur is pointed, dyed, bleached or artificially colored
- 6. Whether the fur product is composed in whole or substantial part (more than 10% of surface area) of pieces, such as paws, tails, bellies, sides, flanks, ears, throats, heads, scraps, or waste fur
- 7. Whether the fur is used or damaged
- 8. The textile or wool content of any part of the product

<u>Size</u>: Labels must be a minimum of 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> by 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> inches.

<u>Durability</u>: The label must be durable enough to remain on the fur until it is delivered to the consumer.

<u>Lettering</u>: The required information must be no smaller than 12 point type, with all parts of the information in letters of equal size and conspicuousness.

## Faux Fur:

For faux fur the only requirement is for the label to have "faux fur" reflected on a label or tag.
