

## CA Identification Number

The CA Identification Number commonly referred to as "CA Number", is a five-digit number preceded by the letters **CA** issued by the Competition Bureau upon request.

Only **Canadian** manufacturers, processors or finishers of a textile fiber product or Canadians engaged in the business of importing or selling any textile fiber product are allowed to register for a CA Identification Number.

Such dealers are not required to have a CA Identification Number but they may use it in place of their name and address on the label of consumer textile articles.
